The Theme

A presumably enzootic virus, SARS-COV-2 (and a host of other such ones) morphed, jumped 'species', broke the 'symbiotic equilibrium' and ran amok as a desperate ploy in a 'survival game'. Human kind, for its part, have set about unlearning a few things hitherto considered sacrosanct in defining, demonstrating notions/expressions for the ones we care for or love - we are practicing 'distancing' ourselves from, rather than seeking 'proximity' to our dear ones as the 'survival etiquette'.

Covid hasn't gone away and it may not all too soon or ever, what with 'Variants of Concern's (VOC) continuing to emerge while we wait for other presumed newer (who knows more sinister) 'emerging infections' with bated breath!

In coping with the pandemic, Health systems too have had to optimize resources, innovate & adopt disruptive strategies. What is pertinent is we must not accord any 'space' to the virus or its variants so it may 'browbeat' us into hosting it. We must zealously continue to take affirmative action in terms of effective behavior change communication (BCC) and pragmatically prevent any further resurgence or 'breakaway spike' from an otherwise presently endemic/ insignificant prevalence of the infection.

At the circumstances, the theme of the conference could not have been more apt and was decided with a view to share & exchange experiences and lessons learned living through pandemic times, of innovation & disruption, of harvesting 'best practices' and arriving at efficient and effective ways for prevention of emerging/re-emerging/resurging infections in future which essentially boils down to checking further deterioration and restoration of the symbiotic equilibrium of the ecosystem presently at peril.

Key Domains of the Theme

1. Epidemiology & Evolving correlates of Emerging , essentially Enzootic Viral infections
2. Community Barriers, Perceptions, Knowledge, Attitude, Hesitancy, Practices vis a vis Covid
3. Innovations & disruptive approaches in teaching, training in Covid times
4. Health System initiatives in sensitizing both provider and the community on Health promotion including Appropriate Behavior Change Communication (BCC) & Practices, Specific protection, Capacity building, Early diagnosis & treatment, Disability limitation & Rehabilitation
5. Effect of the Epidemic on Demography, Social dynamics & Etiquettes, Economics & Livelihood
6. Experiences & Lessons learnt, Best Practices in care & management of COVID and related morbidity
7. Health System readiness & preparedness in strategizing, resource garnering, optimization, management in the event of probable resurgence of infections like Covid

Besides thematic areas, presentations are welcome from any, essentially 'thrust area' of public health importance.

Call for Abstract

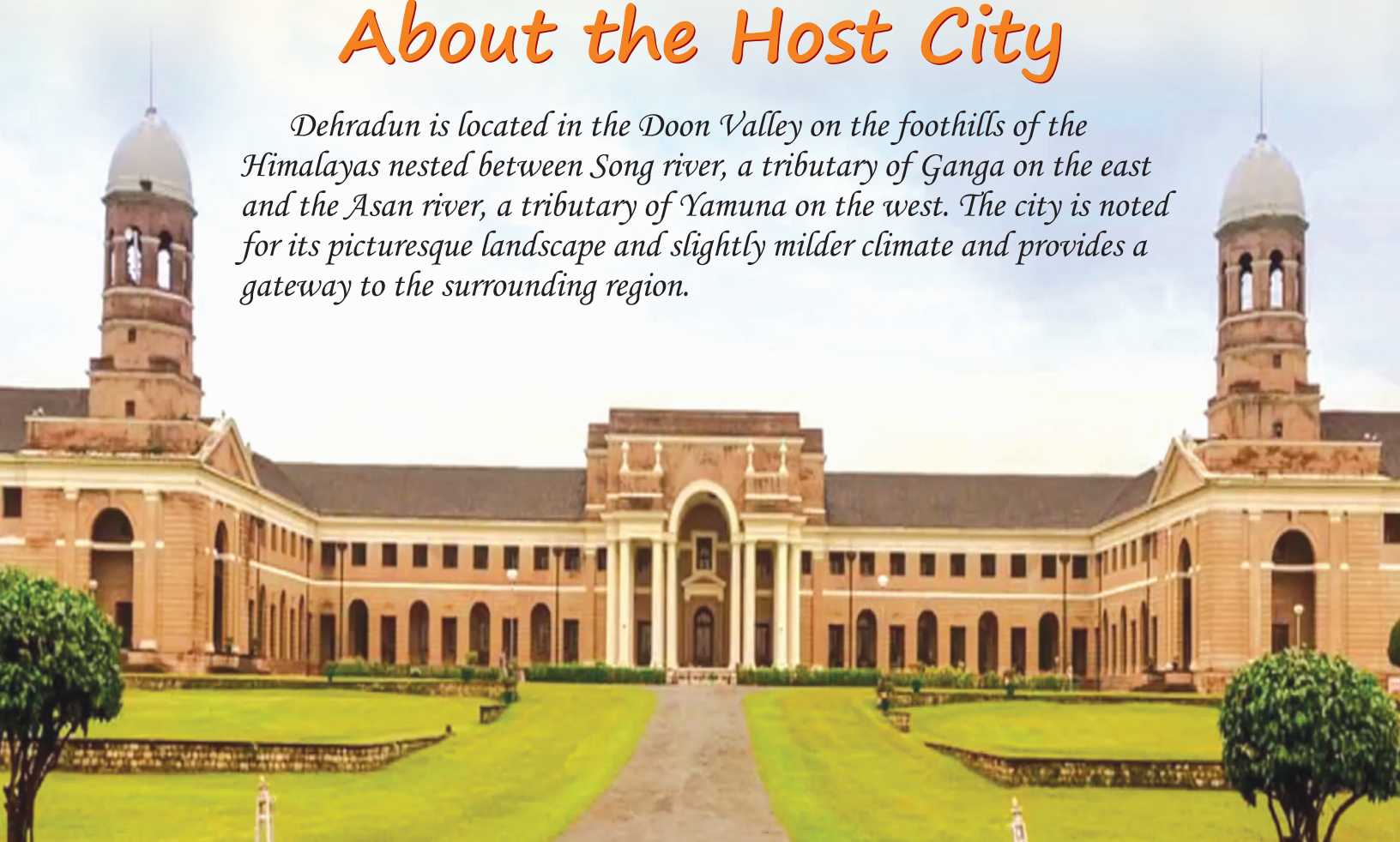
- Registered delegates are requested to submit abstract of their scientific papers for the conference on or before 31st January 2022 clearly mentioning the type of presentation i.e. oral or poster in the subject of the mail.
- The abstract should be limited to 300 words and should include Title, Author's Affiliation, Author's email, brief introduction, Methodology, Results and Conclusion.
- **Oral Presentation:** The oral presentation will be of 10 min (8 mins for presentation and 2 mins for discussion). The facilities for Power Point and Projections will be available at the conference.
- **Poster Presentation:** For the Poster Session, Poster will be displayed in the assigned location by 10 am on the day of poster presentation. The presenting authors are expected to be present at the location during the poster session and for discussion.

Dehradun is located in the Doon Valley on the foothills of the Himalayas nestled between Song river, a tributary of Ganga on the east and the Asan river, a tributary of Yamuna on the west. 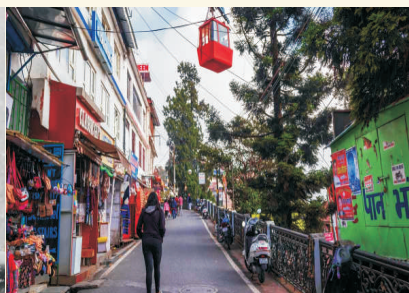
Rishikesh

Located in the foothills of the Himalayas in northern India, it is known as the "Gateway to the Garhwal Himalayas" and "Yoga Capital of the World". It lies 45 km southeast of the state capital Dehradun.



Mussoorie

Mussoorie, also known as Queen of the Hills, is among the most popular hill stations of the country. A Britisher, Captain Frederick Young, accompanied by an official named FJ Shore, had climbed up the hill from the Doon valley in 1827 and found this ridge offering great views and a salubrious climate. GDMC is just 36kms from Mussoorie and easily accessible via well laid road network.
